



***PRIMARY SCHOOL STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS
PRE – RECEPTION CLASS
2009-2010***

The Pre-Reception class is for children who reach the age of four (4) after 1 October in any year, and thus are not eligible for entry into our Reception class. Entry into the class takes place on or after the fourth birthday. At the end of the school year children in the Pre-Reception class enter our Reception class for the following school year. This transfer is automatic and places are guaranteed, although the students will be classed as 'new students' entering Reception.

Please note that normal Admissions criteria apply to all children entering this class.

Students qualify for places if they are:

- Children from other countries who are part of the mobile international community
- Children from Dutch families who have been internationally mobile, and will be internationally mobile in the future, so need to be educated in an international school to ensure continuity of education

When completing your application form applying for a place at the school, or re-registering for the next school year, you will be required to sign that you have read, understood and agreed with these Standard Terms and Conditions. Please take time to read all the clauses in this document as it represents the legal contract between you and the School.

ADMISSION TO THE SCHOOL

Students will be considered for admission to the School upon receipt by the Admissions Officer of a signed application form accompanied by payment of the ***non-refundable registration fee of €300.00*** into the registration account. Afterwards a receipt of payment will be given.

If, after a period of no less than six weeks in school, we feel we cannot meet the academic, social/emotional or physical needs of your child, we reserve the right to recommend a transfer to an establishment that we (the school) believe can better accommodate these needs, or ask that you do so. In this event all fees paid will be refunded.

ENTRY TO THE SCHOOL

School fees must be paid one month in advance of your child's first day in school, into the account on page 2. **The Debtor number, which you will be given after paying your registration fee, should be shown on all payments into the School account to ensure identification.**

DEPOSIT FEE

A deposit of **€1,000.00** must also be paid into the School account before a child may attend the School. This deposit will be refunded when the student leaves the School, providing that all withdrawal paperwork has been completed, all books and resources returned, any outstanding debts cleared, and as long as due notice has been given.

SCHOOL FEES

The fees in this Pre-Reception class are higher than the fees in the remainder of our school as the costs are higher, spread over a smaller period, and we are unable to access the same government subsidies.
