Connecting... What it's all about

A Connector should:

- **Introduce** new students to the **school system**
- Give them a **tour** of the school, showing them the basic areas a student would need (Classrooms, Bathrooms, Canteen)
- Be **friendly** and **welcoming**
- Figure out new students' **needs** and how to **facilitate** their **integration** into the ISH
- **Introduce** new students to other students (depending on the age)
- Get to **know** new students and show them the vast range of extra-curricular **activities**
- **Inform** new students about **Jackie Greenwood**, the ISH Counsellor, who is willing to help them at any time for specific problems
- **Arrange meetings** with new students, either during or after school hours, in order to talk about how they are doing, if they are having any problems or to simply hang out
- **Act as a bridge** between teachers and students and vice versa and give **basic information** about how the school works

Teachers and **Mentors** can also help out new students integrate more easily and smoothly into the ISH.

Teacher and Mentors should:

- Be **welcoming** and **cordial**
- Explain the **MYP/IB system**
- List and describe basic school rules (**Code of Conduct**)
- **Provide** any other sort of **guide**, necessary to understand how to complete certain given tasks (such as MLA handbook)
